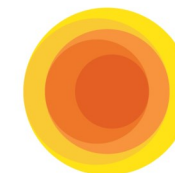

Keynote Speaker



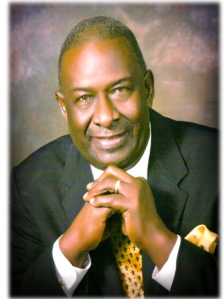
Dr. Rozalynne Wright-Wiggerton, Educational and Diversity Consultant, began her educational career in 1972 as a classroom teacher at R. B. Cox Elementary School in Dade City, Florida. Her 17 years of experience at Cox Elementary School included classroom teacher, Migrant Language Arts Resource Teacher, Assistant Principal, and Principal.

Dr. Wright-Wiggerton has also been employed by the Highlands County School and Collier County School Board. After retiring in 2008, she established ZORAD Consultative Services, LLC. She has served as Supervisor of Instructional and Administrative Interns for several universities, and is currently an External Review Team Lead Evaluator for AdvancED, an accrediting agency for public, private, and charter schools and school districts.

She was recognized for her service in education by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), now a part of AdvancED, being selected as the Florida Recipient of the 2005 John M. Davis Distinguished Educational Achievement Award. She is a Charter Member of the Collier County Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. and is also a member of Beta Sigma Chapter of Alpha Pi Chi Sorority, Inc.

Dr. Wright-Wiggerton attended the public schools of Pasco County through her junior year in high school, transferring as a senior to Rochelle High School in Lakeland, Florida. She earned her Bachelor's Degree in Spanish from Bethune-Cookman College (University) in Daytona Beach, Florida. She earned her Master's Degree in Administration from the University of Tampa in Tampa, Florida, and her Doctorate in Educational Leadership from Nova Southeastern University, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.

Dr. Wright-Wiggerton is the wife of Major Larry Wiggerton, USA, Retired, and the proud mother of two loving children and grandmother of five grandchildren.

Dr. Robert W. Judson, Jr. became Pasco Hernando State College's (PHSC) second President in 1994. Dr. Judson's career at PHSC began in 1972 as a counselor and instructor in Dade City, before there was even a college campus. He taught the first ever PHSC course

and in the following years became PHSC's first coordinator of financial aid. After serving as Dean of the East Campus in Dade City, Dr. Judson became the Provost in 1983. Soon after, he was named Executive Vice President. His appointment as President was particularly ground-breaking, as he was the first African-American president of the modern Florida Community College system.
