Citizens Concerned for Students (CCS) invites you to participate in the very first **Honor Day Soul Food Sampler** to be held Sunday, June 2, 2024 from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. at the Pasco Schools Center for the Arts at Wesley Chapel/Gymnasium in Wesley Chapel, Florida. The Soul Food Sampler will run in conjunction with the College and Career Fair and will precede the annual Honor Day awards ceremony. This year, Honor Day will celebrate and recognize more than 2,600 African American public middle and high school honor roll students in Pasco County for their academic achievements. We estimate that over 900 persons were in attendance at the last awards ceremony.

We invite local Tampa Bay area restaurants and catering businesses who feature Soul Food cuisine to participate in the Soul Food Sampler. Each restaurant/caterer is asked to provide small samples of food (think Sam's Club samples) to the attendees from 4:00 - 6:00 p.m. We anticipate between 200-300 attendees for this event. There is no registration fee to participate and all samples are complimentary. Cooking is not permitted on the premises, however food warmers are allowed to help keep food warm. Restaurants/caterers may choose the food provided, with the exception of any dish or food with any alcoholic ingredients. Forms of advertisement, including restaurant menus, business cards, handouts, door prizes, giveaways and additional promotional items are allowed and encouraged. Each participating restaurant/caterer will also be advertised on the Honor Day website in a special eBrochure.

Registration is complimentary and free of charge and may be submitted online at [www.HonorDayPasco.org](http://www.HonorDayPasco.org). Tables and seating will be provided. The deadline to register is Monday, May 27, 2024. - Take Exit 279 (Zephyrhills/Wesley Chapel) off Interstate 75 at State Road 54 and travel East for 1 mile
- Turn Left (North) at the traffic light on to Vandine Road (becomes Boyette Road)
- Travel 1.3 miles and turn right (East) on Wells Road
- The School is the second campus on the North side of Wells Road
